Welcome

Welcome to our affordable Breakfast Club run by Barwic Parade Community Primary School for the benefit of pupils of Barwic Parade.

What do we stand for?

It's important that you know that we are a **non profit making** club aiming to provide a **warm, secure and enjoyable** place for your child to start their school day, where they can enjoy a **healthy and filling** breakfast, talk to their friends and have an opportunity to read or work on homework before school starts. We want to send children into school **ready to learn**.

Opening Times

We are open each weekday morning between **7.45am and 8.45am**. Your child can be dropped off at any time during this period. Children remain in the care of the Breakfast Club team until they join their class.

Please note that breakfast is not served after 8.30am.

Roles & Responsibilities

Miss Kelly Garbutt leads our Breakfast Club team. You can take reassurance that Miss Garbutt is fully qualified in areas such as food hygiene and first aid and has over 10 years of relevant experience of working with children and is qualified to Level 3 in Childcare. Miss Garbutt is supported by a number of other key team members.

Children will be encouraged to be independent. They may help themselves to breakfast; clearing away their own breakfast dishes when they are finished. We want to provide as near as possible to the atmosphere of a family meal at home.

Breakfast Menu

Choice of cereals
Freshly cooked toast and bagels with a choice low sugar spreads or low fat cheese

Where possible any special dietary requirements will be catered for – just talk to us

From time to time we will hold 'Special Breakfast' events where the menu can include pancakes, waffles, and even bacon sandwiches !

Behaviour

Children attending our Breakfast Club are expected to behave according to the expectations set out in the school's behaviour policy, **being ready, respectful and safe** at all times.

Incidents of inappropriate behaviour can and will be reported to the school Headteacher and persistent poor behaviour will lead to a child being asked not to attend our Breakfast Club.

Bookings, fees and payments

There is no need to book in advance. Just turn up.

The cost of each session is £2 per child. Payment can be made in cash at the School Office or via your online school Parent Pay account.

The school really does believe in the importance of a good breakfast and the positive impact on learning so for every £2 you spend - Barwic Parade Community Primary School will contribute £3 towards the cost of the running the breakfast club - keeping the cost to parents/carers as low as possible.
