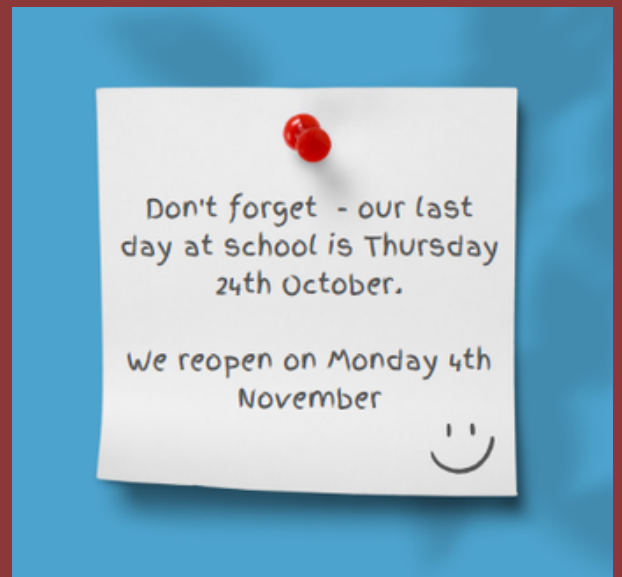
Nursery Places - 2, 3 & 4 year olds
