Additionally, please note that the school photographer will be visiting on 25th September. This is a wonderful chance to capture those precious school memories, so ensure your children are looking their best on the day.

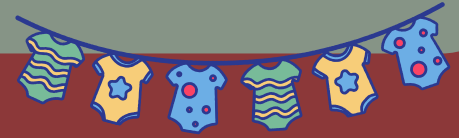
