The aim of this programme is to help patients, who are about to embark on surgery and/or treatment for their Cancer, be as strong and healthy to help them recover better, build resilience and minimise side effects. They also offer a Rehabilitation Programme - The aim of this programme is to help patients who are post-surgery/treatment regain some strength and create a healthy lifestyle to help them live their best life beyond Cancer. There is also access

to dietitian and support from our Cancer care coordinator who looks after patient's well being and offers holistic support.
